

Parking

Parking around town can be tricky. Below are a few helpful tips. We are not in control of parking structures, and any changes they make in their policy regarding rates and accessibility are at their discretion. Ultimately, you must decide where you want to park and how far you want to walk.

A few tips:

Download the app: SpotHero. Although not exhaustive of parking options in the city, you can schedule where you want to park and pay in advance taking the stress out of trying to find something when the clock is ticking and you need to get to work.

Marcus Performing Arts Center: There is a parking structure on the corner of State and Water that is affiliated with MPAC. This is most commonly used by Stagehands and is centrally located to get to MPAC, Miller High Life Theatre, Panther Arena, Pabst, The Rep, etc. Please see their signs for updated parking rates. There is a reduced parking rate for MPAC employees. This information is provided by MPAC.

Fiserv Forum: Information is available onsite for parking at an affiliated structure for a reduced rate. Employees can also go to the website: [tapnpark](#) to register and prepay for the Highland Parking Garage. Hourly parking rates are below for reference: (rates valid as of 3/27/2024)

First 3 Hours - \$3.24

4 Hours - \$4.32

5 Hours - \$5.40

6 Hours - \$6.47

7 Hours - \$7.55

8-12 Hours - \$8.63

Meters: There are few hidden spots that have 10 hour meters if you're willing to walk a few extra blocks. The spots that typically have open spaces are around Clybourn and St. Paul near the Amtrak station. There is also a row along both Edison and Market Streets running between Juneau and Knapp.
