STEWARD CONTACT INFO

Late, lost, or last minute cancel? Contact the Stewards:

Assigned Stewards and contact information will be provided on a show by show basis.

THE STEWARD'S ROLE

- Upon arrival, immediately check in with the Steward. They will be positioned at the North Dock Entrance. If you don't check in, you won't get paid. They must know you are present and ready to start the call.
- The Steward will tell you when you can take a break, go for a meal, and when you are done for the day.
- The Steward might assign you to a department.
- If the tour personnel tells you they are done with you for their project, you go to the Steward for further instructions. Do not leave until the Steward dismisses you.
- The Stewards are your union representatives. If you have a question, problem, or concern, talk to the Steward.

PARKING

LOAD IN: Park in the Matthews Lot.

SHOW CALL: Park in the Spahn Lot.

LOAD OUT: Park in the Spahn Lot.

STAGEHANDS ENTRANCE

Enter at the NORTH DOCK. Immediately check in with the Steward upon arrival. The North Dock is below the restaurant newly named *J Leinenkugel's Barrel Yard*, formerly known as the *Restaurant to be Named Later* and formerly *TGIF's*. The entrance goes under the highway, accessed on the west side of the American Family parking lot.

PLAN FOR YOUR DAY

- Hours originally scheduled may change. In the event of a time change, re-confirm a call as quickly as possible if prompted to do so in Call Steward.
- END TIMES in Call Steward are an estimate only. Plan on staying and being available all day.
- Traffic into the property is unpredictable during load out. Please allow extra time to park and walk to the north dock. The walk from Spahn lot can take 10-15 minutes. **See maps below**

BREAKS AND MEALS

- Breaks are a courtesy and up to the discretion of the tour, typically called 2 -2.5 hours into the start of your call. Bring a refillable water bottle and snacks as needed.
- Meals might be provided as required under the contract, generally this happens if you work past 5 hours and only given a 30 minute break. If meals are not provided, you will be given a one hour walk-away.

RECOMMENDED ATTIRE, TOOLS and PPE:

Our Business depends on the quality of service we provide and, in part, upon our professional image. Accordingly, IATSE Local 18 referrals are always expected to present a neat, professional appearance. The IATSE Local 18 Referral Hall recognizes the fact that different styles and attire will be necessary, depending on safety, weather, nature of work and degree of customer contact.

Stadium Work Clothes: Well-fitting and clean clothing, that is not tattered, is preferred. Black clothes are expected to be worn if assigned to a show call. Clothing with inappropriate graphics/words, advertisements, social commentary, and/or pictures should not be worn. Union designation, previous concert or stage event T-shirts are acceptable.

Bring your basic tool kit and PPE: 8” crescent wrench, work gloves, closed toed shoes, and multi-tool with a knife. It is requested to bring a high visibility vest if you are a down rigger. Hard hat recommended, but not required.

GETTING PAID

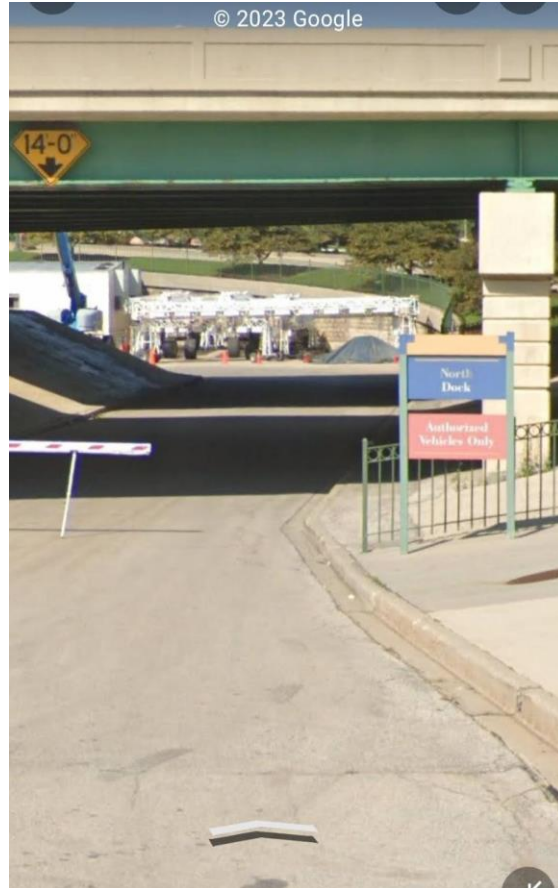
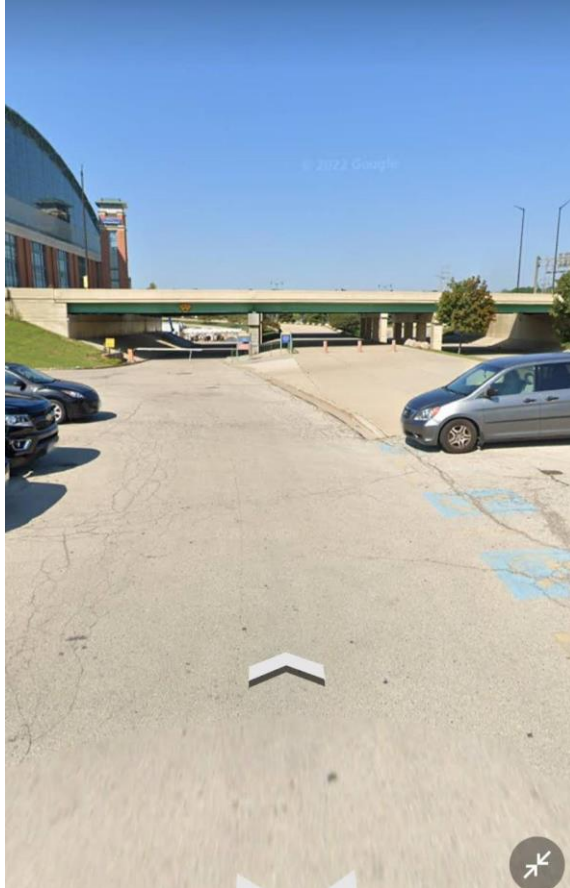

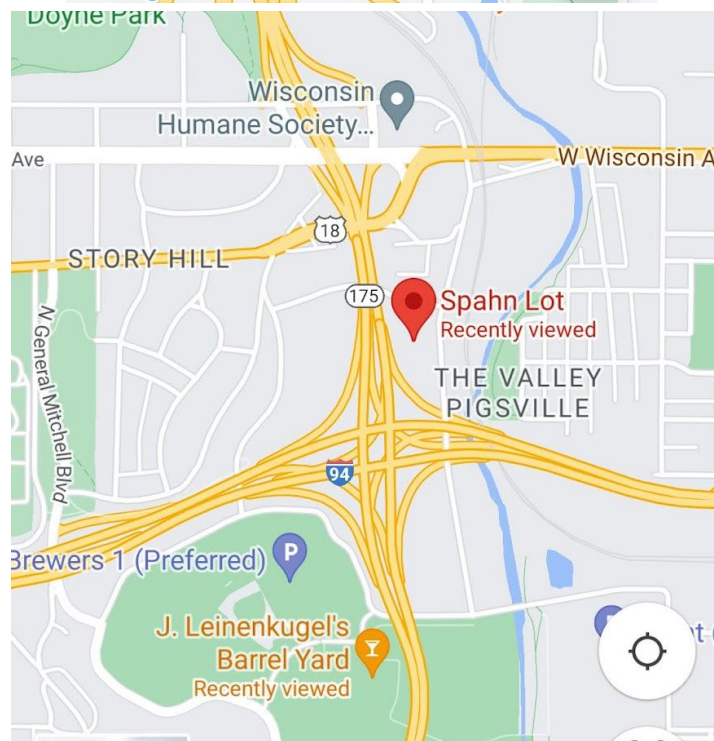
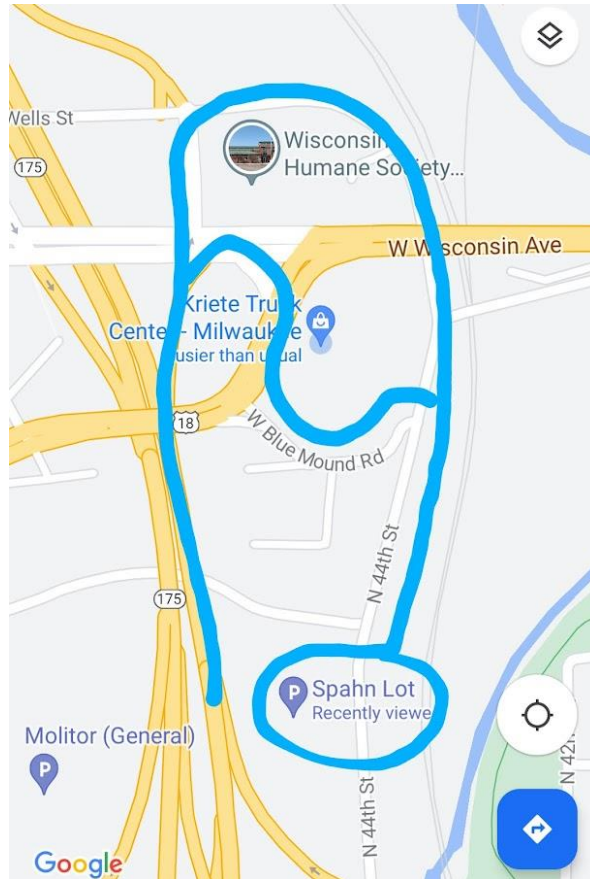
North Dock Entrance
